We were sorry to hear that Peggy Trebalka passed away.

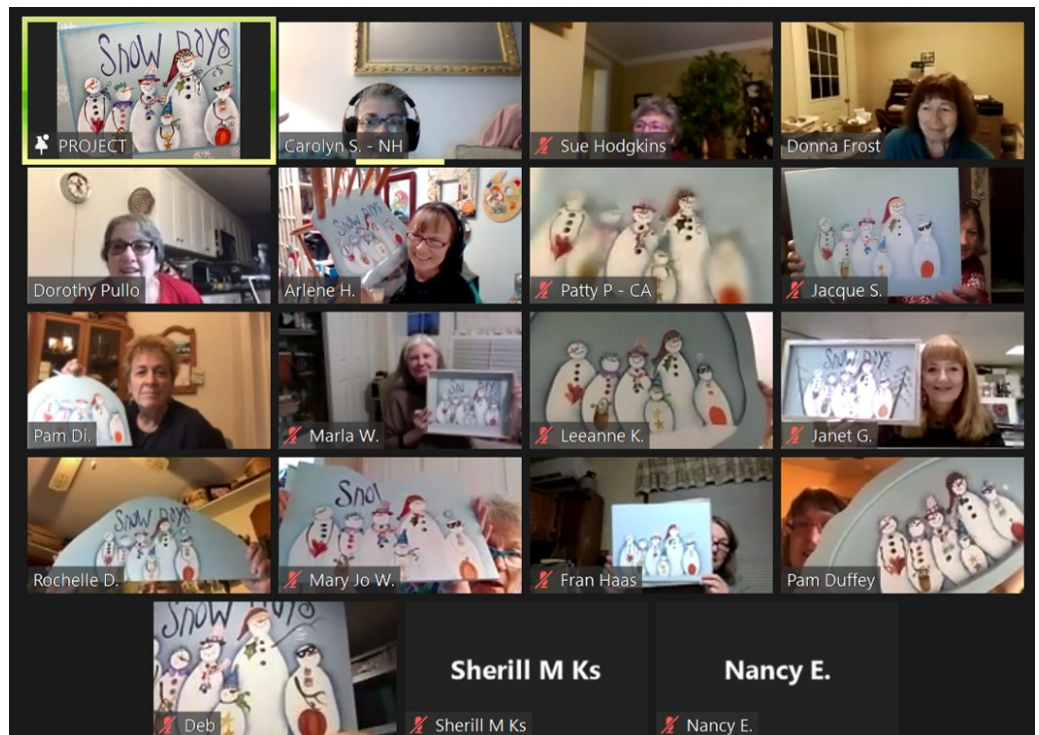

Suzanne will walk us through the steps to paint this beautiful flower, and there is no traditional floating done with a sideloaded brush. For those that struggle to float or for traditional floaters that want to try something new, this is an opportunity for you to try something different. You may be amazed how easy it is to develop dimension using filbert and scumbler brushes to stroke and blend colors together.

The volunteer teacher makes the arrangements with SDP to get the packet and choose a date during the Paint In Month and White Mountain will supply the zoom talent. If you haven't taught a Zoom class before you will need two different internet devices. Most teachers are using a cell phone on a gooseneck holder for the close ups and their regular Zoom device i.e. laptop, desk-top, tablet to see the class.

to volunteer for the design you want to teach. We'll find out during which month it can be taught and explain the next step in obtaining the packet.



Keep in Touch

We use an email service to email the newsletter to members but to access the newsletter you have to click on a link in the email. Because we are selling things like raffle tickets and seminars, we have to use a service that provides an "opt out" (unsubscribe) that a member can use that will take place right away so we are not guilty of spamming. The email service also works with email providers to guarantee we aren't spamming and so our newsletter emails do not end up in your junk file.

To click on the link or any link, move your mouse to that word or sentence and do a left click. If you aren't using a mouse but a cell phone, tablet, or iPad, tap on the word or sentence with your finger.

If you lose a newsletter you can find the current and past newsletters posted on our website www.wmdpghn.org. The newsletter is posted on the website soon after it is emailed.

Join our Facebook Page!

The newsletter editor also announces on our Facebook page when the newsletter has been emailed. Printed newsletters go to the post office within a day or two of the email.

Our Facebook page is also a good way to see reminders and sometimes some tips that are shared from other websites.

There are so many techniques incorporated into this design that you do not want to miss this program. To name a few: Mudding, Colorants and Strokes.

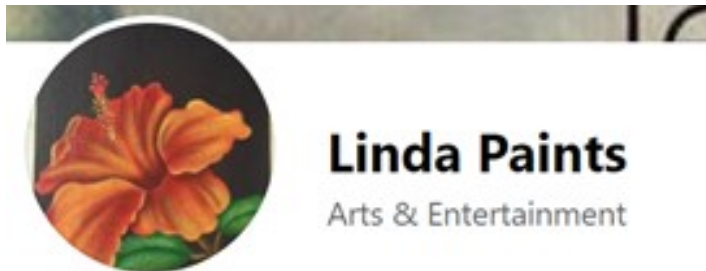
